Description

The Marset Funiculi is a new edition of a lamp designed in 1979. Lluis Porqueras has always sought an absolute simplicity in his designs, doing away with everything superfluous to leave the essence of the useful, simple object. 30 years on, Funiculi remains highly contemporary, both in its purist forms and in its features. The name Funiculi comes from the concept of a “funicular” action – moving up and down. The mechanism for raising and lowering the lamp uses a pair of clips which make it very easy to change the height of the shade to meet the user’s needs. The shade itself can be rotated through 360 degrees to point the light wherever it is required. The base of Funiculi is covered in rubber on the bottom, avoiding the cold contact between the metal and the floor and adding stability to the lamp. It is available in black, cream-white, green, terracotta, mustard yellow and moss grey.
